Growing up she lived the majority of her youth in Scotts Bluff, Nebraska graduating from Gering High School. Betty was involved in high school competitions for typing and vocal contests. She won superior rating in a tri state competition as a solo soprano and participated in mixed octets & girls sextet.

After moving to Burbank, California Betty worked as a "Rosie the Riveter" during World War II at Lockheed Aircraft where she met her future husband, Sidney Wachs. They were married in 1945 while Sid was serving in the Navy, the couple had two daughters. Betty worked part time in several office positions while being active in her daughters schooling and PTA.

Betty & Sid moved to Lincoln City in 1982 and quickly immersed themselves in PADL (Preservation Association of Devils Lake), Kiwanis & the Hospital Auxiliary. Betty enjoyed playing tennis, music appreciation club, she also supported numerous other community groups including Theater West, Connie Hansen Gardens Conservancy & Monday night community dinner at the Episcopal Church. Her artistic abilities were evident in her various quilting projects, stained glass, sewing and paper crafts. Betty & Sid traveled extensively to Europe, Australia, New Zealand and took several cruises -

while vacationing Betty acquired a variety of collectables.
