



Kelly Lambert

February 11, 1975 - January 27, 2018

Jerry Kelly Lambert passed away in his home in Scottsdale, Arizona on January 27, 2018. Kelly was born on February 11, 1975 in Santa Rosa California to Jerry and Carolyn Lambert (McCardell) of Lincoln City, Oregon.

Kelly spent most of his early life in Lincoln City, Oregon. He graduated from Taft High School in 1993. During his time at Taft, he played basketball, ran track and cross country. Kelly found particular passion for running and excelled during his last year of high school, finishing 2nd in the cross country state meet his senior year. In track, he set the school record for the 800 meters and still holds the record for the 1500 meters at 4:00.70. He was voted most athletic in his senior class.

Kelly continued his education at University of Portland, receiving a B.A. in History, while running both track and cross-country. He was a four year letterman in cross country.

Post-collegiately Kelly moved to Boulder, CO and worked himself into being one of the fastest 10k runners in the country, racing in the National Championships in 1998 and mentioned in the book, Running with the Buffaloes.

On September 19, 2015 Kelly married the love of his life Tennille (Brown).

Along with his wife and children Molly and Mateo, Kelly is survived by his mother Carolyn, brothers Brian, Sean and Michael, his sister Jeannie, sister in-law Shae, nieces Sophia and Hailey and nephew Nathan. Kelly was preceded in death by his father Jerry Lambert and brother Jeffery.

A memorial will be held on February 10, 2018 at 11am in Lincoln City, Oregon at the St Augustine Catholic Church. The reception will be held at Eden Hall in Gleneden Beach immediately following the memorial.
