Mark was born January 29, 1947 to Lowell & Alice (Busing) Snyder in Eugene, Oregon. He died suddenly at North Lincoln Hospital in Lincoln City, Oregon on October 18, 2017.

Mark grew up in Toledo, Oregon, after graduating high school he joined the Coast Guard being honorable discharged after four years of service obtaining a National Defense Service Medal & Coast Guard Good Conduct Medal in 1971 in Depoe Bay, Oregon. He continued his education earning a bachelors degree from Southern Oregon University in Ashland, Oregon. Mark married Susan J. Robison in 1973 at the Congregational Church in Lincoln City, Oregon where they are still active members, together having two children. He earned the Oregon Golf Course Superintendent of the year, was a board member and president of the Oregon Golf Course Superintendents, NW Turfgrass Association and Oregon Association of Water Utilities. During his work career he was a golf course superintendent at Salishan Lodge for 20 plus years also working for Kernville, Gleneden Beach and Lincoln Beach water systems for 19 years.
