Peter Lacques passed away quietly in his home on November 24, 2015. He is survived by his loving wife, Elle, nine children, two stepchildren, eight grandchildren and two great grandchildren. Peter was born in New York, New York on March 13, 1929. Peter proudly served in the US Marine Corps during the Korean War, participating in the capture of Seoul and the Chosin Reservoir Campaign. He was honorably discharged in July, 1952.

Peter had a Bachelor of Science degree in agriculture from Cal Poly in San Luis Obispo. He worked in farm management and land development in California, Houston and Hawaii. Peter and Elle moved to Gleneden Beach in 1997 and, in 2003, established the Oregon Coast Learning Institute (OCLI). He volunteered with CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocate) and served on the citizen review board.

Peter was laid to rest in the Willamette National Cemetery in Portland. He will be sorely missed by all who knew and loved him.
