Ronald Pinyerd was born in Washington's Yakima Valley in 1937. The family soon moved to Rose Lodge, Oregon, in 1939. He attended Taft High School where he was a three-sport athlete. Ron remained a life-long Oregonian leaving only for a hitch in the Army. He worked in the lumber mills around Eugene while attending the University of Oregon for a degree in political science. After marrying and having a son, he became a general contractor. He remained a general contractor in Oregon for the next 42 years until his passing. Many readers have likely had Ron work on their house. He was often stubborn but always generous. Ron married Marilyn Ward in 2010, they traveled around the world together, and she kept very good care of him until the end.

He is survived by his wife Marilyn Pinyerd, son David Pinyerd, brother Dick Pinyerd, and stepfather Duane Garoutte.
